

Write a Legacy Letter!

A letter that entrusts to your loved ones your values and Catholic faith and explains how these values have influenced your philanthropy at the end of your life



Template for Writing a One-Page Legacy Letter

Dear Family:

Paragraph 1 // **Provide Context:** The purpose of this letter is to explain how the values that relate to our Catholic Faith influenced the charitable gift portion of our estate plan, particularly our decision to leave a gift to (our parish/our Catholic School or (fill in the blank)

Paragraph 2 // **Tell the Story:** One of the things we loved about our Catholic Faith or practicing our Faith in our parish or (Fill in the blank) was....

Paragraph 3 // **Share the lesson/learning:** As we near the end of our lives we realize how grateful we are for all the 'gifts' God has blessed our family with. We've tried to be good stewards of those gifts and now realize our stewardship doesn't have to end when we pass from this life...

Paragraph 4 // **Offer a blessing:** Our blessing for you is that you always appreciate the Christian values of stewardship that we have passed on and that you will pass these values on to your children one day.....
